Singletree Acres - Surveyor Review Comments March 2, 2024

Below are the response to comments to the comments that were given on Mar 2nd, 2024 for the Singletree Acres Subdivision located at 4520 West & 2200 South in Taylor, Utah.

Weber County Survey Department – Bridger Curtis – Document Comments

1. Tie to POB not parallel to lot line, L1 & L2 not parallel to lot line or centerline. Did you intend to have it skewed?

2. There need to be dimensions to and from the beginning and ends of the curves.

3. Need to dedicate Easement to Weber County.

Response: See updated plat

4. Here I am looking for a distance from the Lot Line to the Centerline along the boundary, not the street half width. Since the CL of the street isn't perpendicular to the boundary the distance should be shown.

5. Storm Drain easement needs to be dedicated to Weber County.

6. Tie to POB doesn't match tie in legal description.

7. 30' dimension.

10. How did you determine the boundary? If you're holding the points set by Reeve, what document did you use to retrace their position?
