RE: Written response to Blane Frandsen Review Dated 1/9/2017

1. A Storm Water Construction Activity Permit is required for all work that disturbs more than 5000 square feet. *(The permit will be completed and applied for by the contractor as per contract specifications before any work is to commence).*
2. A Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) is now required to be submitted for all new development where construction is required. This requires that a Utah Discharge Pollution Elimination Systems (UPDES) permit be acquired for all new development. A copy of the permit needs submitted to the county before final approval. Permits can now be obtained online thru the Utah State Department of Environmental Quality a following web site: <https://secure.utah.gov/swp/client>. *(Contractor will submit (UPDES) permit to county prior to construction).*
3. Please see the posted Plan Review regarding the construction drawings. *(The plans have been revised as per comments from review and are attached for your review. Note that the SWPPP Notes pages were omitted due to being redundant information with the UPDES permit which will be applied for and managed by the Contractor who is awarded the project).*
