- 1. How much area will be disturbed
  - a. 3650 Square Feet
- 2. Who will be responsible for the conditions for the site during construction?
  - a. Own and subcontractors
- 3. What will be done to prevent the neighbors from being affected by the proposed construction activities?
  - a. There are currently no immediate neighbors. Best judgement will be used to ensure closets neighbors are not affected any more than the occasional vehicle passing by on the road.
- 4. What will be done with all excavated material temporarily and permanently?
  - a. All excavated material will be reused to grading and landscaping.
- 5. Where is the concreted washout and how will it be maintained?
  - a. See map for location. Washout will be cleaned as needed by excavator/shovel.
- 6. Where are the Porta-Johns located and how are they installed?
  - a. See map for location. Units will be portable drop off type.
- 7. How will the construction entrance be built and where will it be located?
  - a. See map for location. Entrance is built using an 18" corrugated steel pipe, backfield with soil and covered with road-base.
- 8. What will you do when Mud and/or dirt gets tracked on the asphalt?
  - a. Nearest asphalt road almost half a mile away. Mud/dirt on the asphalt won't have come from the construction site.
- 9. Is there a drainage ditch or swale on or near your property? How will it be protected?
  - a. Yes. It will be protected by use of the provided entrance. Construction activities will not otherwise impact the ditch.
- 10. What currently happens to the rain/storm water when it reaches this project site?
  - a. It nearly all soaks into the ground. What little does not runs down the drainage ditch and into a massive drainage system built by the army corp of engineers.
