- 2. Type and description of event:
 - a. Spartan Race will be producing an eight mile trail run with obstacles placed throughout the course. In addition to the adult race, there will be a festival area where sponsors will set up, merchandise will be sold, food can be consumed, and people will spend time watching their friends and families. Lastly, there will also be a one-mile kids obstacle race for children ages six to thirteen.

 - a. Race dates are Saturday, July 28th, 2018 Sunday, July 29th, 2018
 - b. Festival open: 6:00AM
 - c. Festival closes after last racer finishes or course cutoff: projected to be at 10:00PM.
 - d. Additional event: 12 Hour Hurricane Heat begins at 8:00PM on Friday, July 27th ends at 8:00AM on Saturday, July 28th

 - a. Address and Legal Description of Property where assembly is to be held:

 - b. Proof of Ownership on which Assembly is to be held:

 - c. Nature & Purpose of Assembly:
 - i. Spartan Race is designed as a sport/ entertainment event to encourage a healthy lifestyle.
 - d. Plans for Limiting Attendance:
 - i. Spartan Race will enclose festival area on all sides and have staff, volunteers, and security monitor the perimeters. Guests will be directed towards our entry/registration where they will have to be identified with a wrist band as being able to enter our event.
 - e. Plans for Fencing and Gates
 - Spartan race will enclose festival on all sides with fencing that will be staked and weighed down with sandbags. The only flexible openings will

be at medical for emergency access. Guests are directed towards registration for entry.

- f. Plans for Supplying potable Water including Source and Location of Outlets:
 - i. There will be 9 water stations at the event. Seven of those stations will be on course aid stations and two of those stations will be in the festival area. Spartan Race will use a combination of bottled water, jugs, and large refillable containers to provide water on course as well as within the festival area. The containers will be filled via clear, potable hoses attached to potable spigots identified by Nordic Valley staff on their own property. The refillable containers will be lined with one-time use disposable potable water bags. These will be changed in between use. Lastly, Spartan Race is ordering enough cups to serve water based on our projected registration numbers of 6,700 with a buffer of 20 percent extra. These cups will be allocated across 9 water stations. Volunteers and staff will monitor quantities at each water station and call on radio for extra if needed.

g. Plans for Providing Toilet Facilities

i. Spartan Race will be renting 95 regular portable toilets, 10 ADA portable toilets, and 12 hand wash stations throughout the festival area and parking area. Spartan staff will constantly monitor the quantities of toilet paper, paper towels, and soap in the portable toilets and replenishing the quantities as needed.

h. Plans for Garbage Disposal

i. Spartan Race will provide either (3) 40 yard dumpsters or (4) 30 yard dumpsters for all event waste. Two will be placed in the festival area and one will be placed at the Spartan base camp. More than 100 trash receptacles will be placed throughout the festival area as well as on course at the water stations.

i. Plans for Medical Services

i. Spartan Race will contract with Event Medics to provide on site emergency and medical services. Spartan Race will also be having three Ambulances on site from Weber Fire District for the duration of the race. Additionally, Spartan Race will have Event Medics and one ambulance on site for the duration of the 12 Hour Hurricane Heat from Friday, July 27th at 8:00PM until 8:00AM on Saturday, July 28th.

j. Plans for Illuminating Location:

i. Sunrise is estimated for 6:27AM and sunset at 8:40PM. Outside of these hours Spartan Race will be renting light towers to illuminate the festival and parking areas. Racers starting past a certain time will be required to carry a headlamp. Later in the day course cutoffs will be enforced by the race director and anyone not carrying a headlamp will be pulled off course.

k. Plans for Parking:

- i. Spartan Race will utilize an on site lot to park staff, vendors, and some VIP guests. This lot can fit 200 cars. For general parking Spartan Race will be contracting with an off site lot at 3980 N 3500 E, Eden, UT 84310 which can fit up to 3,700 cars. Lastly, Spartan will rent the necessary amount of shuttles to transport guests from the off site lot to the assembly location.
- I. Plans for Telephone Services:
 - i. Spartan Race management staff will have working cell phones while on site to communicate with people off the venue. Amongst the staff, Spartan Race will be utilizing radios to communicate with each other at the venue.
- m. Plans for Camping Facilities:
 - i. Spartan will not offer camping.
- n. Security Plans:
 - i. Spartan Race will have staff, volunteers, and hired security to monitor the perimeters. Only guests with a Spartan Race wristband will be allowed into the festival area which they get after going through registration.
- o. Fire Protection Plans:
 - i. Spartan race will place approved and up to date fire extinguishers in all of its 20x20 tents and 10x20 structures. Spartan Race will contract with equipment operator to cut all tall grass in parking and festival area before the event weekend to minimize contact with exhaust pipes. Lastly, Spartan Race is planning to have a fire jump obstacle near the finish line. This is a small bonfire set atop of pad of gravel with a staff member stationed at the fire at all times. Alongside him is a larger fire extinguisher, fire suit, and access to fire hose to put out fire. Lastly, Spartan Race will stay up to date on wildfire risk in the counties and cancel the obstacle if mandated by the county.
