Upon receipt of an invoice of the costs incured by UDOT, permitte shall immediately pay the amount due. If an action is required to be filed in court to collect the amount due, permittee shall be liable for UDOT's costs and fees, including attorney's fees.

Before work permitted is commenced, the permittee shall notify the permits inspector listed below and Tommy Vigil (801)-791-4988. By applying for the Permit and UDOT issuing the Permit, permittee will comply with all instructions, conditions, requirements, and regulations of UDOT with respect to performance of the work described in the Permit. Permittee will properly control and warn the public of said work withit UDOT's rights-of-way to prevent any accidents. Permittee shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless UDOT from all damages or claims, including attorneys fees, arising out of any and all actions performed under this Permit by permittee, permittee's employees, agents or contractors, incuding failure to comply with terms and conditions in this Permit. Permittee shall pay for UDOT's inspections fees.

Permittee shall not perform any work on state highway rights-of-way beyond those areas of operation described on this Permit.

If permittee fails to comply with UDOT's regulations, specifications, or instructions pertinent to this Permit, the Region Director/District Engineer or his duly authorized representative, may by verbal order, suspend the work until the violation is corrected. If permittee fails or refuses to promptly comply, the Region Director/District Engineer or his authorized representative may issue a written order stopping all or any part of the work. When satisfactory corrective action is taken, an order permitting resumption of work may be issued.

Special Limitations:

- Contractors working in UDOT's right-of-way must maintain access to transit facilities. Contractor shall notify UTA of all bus stops within work zone at least 1 business day prior to placing traffic control. Contractor shall keep access to bus stops for both passengers and buses, or provide an alternative approved by UTA. Both preserved and alternate access must match existing conditions or meet ADA standards. The contact at UTA is Ken Anson 801.227.8957 or kanson@rideuta.com. Bus stop access requirements may be waived by the UDOT permits officer on days when the bus does not run.
- Untreated Base Course with 97% compaction for the full depth of the trench with 6" lifts.
- Must use PG asphalt. Saw cut and tack joints. Asphalt replace to 6" minimum with 3" lifts.
- An inspector may be required at permittee's expense, with 48 hours notice. By accepting this permit, I agree to pay for inspection fees.
- Licensee is responsible for repairing and/or restoring any portion of the roadway damaged during construction.
- Licensee must restore shoulder of highway to its original or better condition. Including reseeding, replacing sidewalk, fencing, pipe, culverts or signs removed or damaged during construction and any other roadway features.

- Permit Holder will comply with all applicable environmental laws.
