



UTAH HIGH SCHOOL CYCLING LEAGUE
COVID EVENT PRECAUTIONS PLAN 2020 Version 2.0
LAST UPDATED 7/7/2020

As the Utah High School Cycling League we take the health and safety of our students, coaches, volunteers, and staff very seriously. As the phased guidelines are ever-changing, we are keeping up with the requests and policies that have been put forth from our Governor in his Utah Leads Together Guidance System.

Attendance & Symptom Monitoring:

- Symptom checks will be handled by each team's head coach or team director. This will go to all student-athletes and coaches.
- Families attending will be asked to self monitor prior to arriving at the venue and not attend the event if they have any of the symptoms associated with COVID 19.
- We will ask high-risk attendees not to attend the events or to take extra precautions if they should decide to move forward.
- The Head Coach or Team Director will track attendance of participants & spectators that will be joining their team.
- The Race Director will request that all race crew completes a symptom check list before attending the event.
- These measures above will assist with contact tracing.

Social Distancing:

- Masks or face coverings will be required by all attendees. These must be worn when you are in close proximity to others and can not social distance yourself from others.

Signage:

- At restrooms reminding patrons to wash hands or use hand sanitizer after each use.
- At water stations to use a personal water bottle or request a free cup at the registration table. Sanitizing wipes available at the water stations so users may sanitize the spigot before they use it
- Signs reminding patrons to not share items unless sanitized between uses.
- Health Department signs reminding patrons to wear a mask or face covering when in close proximity to others.
- Signs reminding patrons to social distance whenever possible
- We will be printing up several CDC signs that have been provided and place them at entrances and high traffic areas.

Payment Options:

- Registration is all done in advance. No money transactions are needed.



- Merchandise purchases or Food Truck purchases will be by credit card (minimizing cash transactions), if still a concern as we move forward.

Hygiene & Sanitation:

- Portable restrooms will all be required to have hand sanitizer in each unit.
- Hand wash stations will be at all portable restrooms with 4 or more units.
- Sanitizing stations will be located throughout the venue
- Hand Sanitizer will be available at all tent locations throughout the infield
- Frequently touched items will be sanitized throughout the day such as restroom door handles, tables and water stations.

Race Crew Precautions:

- Symptom checklist prior to attending the race
- Must wear a face mask or face covering when in close proximity to others when social distancing isn't an option.
- Wash hands frequently during the day.
- Sanitize any shared items between uses. Examples: microphones, tablets, computers, crossing guard signs, radios, etc.
- Repeat PSA's about washing hands, wearing face coverings, and social distancing throughout the day

Volunteer Precautions:

- Symptom checklist prior to attending the race
- Must wear a face mask or face covering when in close proximity to others when social distancing isn't an option.
- Wash hands frequently during the day.
- Volunteer vest will only be worn once at an event and then placed in a laundry bag to be washed before the next event.
- Monitor water stations and sanitize frequently throughout the day. Provide a clean cup when requested.
- Use contact less payment in registration and merchandise.
- Make sure riders, spectators, and coaches are abiding by posted precautions of social distancing and face coverings.
- Sanitize the equipment in their area throughout the day.
- Temperature checks on student-athletes as they line up to start the race. Prior to taking masks down to race.
- If needed they will limit the number of people in the merchandise tent at one time.
- Manage portable restrooms & handwashing stations - makes sure they are stocked and sanitized throughout the day



Feed Zone:

The Feed Zone is the location at the races where teams can offer food and water to their racers on course that are doing multiple laps.

- Food items must be prepacked
- Water bottles must NOT be shared amongst team members
- Sanitize all water bottles in between races
- No sharing of water bottles will be tolerated
- Coaches and volunteers will wear a mask while in close proximity to others

Pit Zone Sheriff:

The Pit Zone Sheriff will make sure that teams are being compliant at the races. They will inspect the tent to make sure teams are following the policies set forth from our Governor, UHSCL and the local venue where we will be racing.

- Conducting team tent inspections during set up and on race day
- Sanitize frequently-used items in pit zone
- Making sure teams are following all guidelines that they are expected to uphold during the events.
- Wear a mask while in close proximity to others

Food Trucks:

- Must abide by all rules set forth by the Governor's Office and the local health department for concessions
- Must provide hand sanitizer
- Must offer contactless payment options.
- Must sanitize all areas associated with their food truck during the event

Sponsors:

- Must provide hand sanitizer
- Must sanitize frequently touched items at their tent
- Wear masks while in close proximity to others

Teams:

- Responsible for ensuring that the symptom checklist is completed by all racers, parents and other attendees associated with their team prior to arrival at the venue
- Keeping attendance of those planning to attend the race (families of the racers)
- Sanitize frequently-touched areas within their tent area
- Have hand sanitizer available in their tent
- Reminding student athletes, parents and coaches to keep a mask on while in close proximity to others
- Pass a team tent checklist



Race Director:

The race director is assisting all areas throughout the day and making sure that race production goes off as planned. They are in constant communication with all race crew, coaches, racers, volunteers and families that attend.

- Will assist all areas that are in need of help getting things cleaned
- Sanitize frequently-touched areas throughout the race
- Will assist with portable restrooms and hand wash stations to make sure we are sanitizing frequently-touched areas
- Wear a mask while in close proximity to others

Please note: This is based on version 4.6 and will be adjusted or changed according to the Governors Utah Leads Together Guidelines. While all policies are best to move forward with, some may be added or deleted as needed.
