SUBJECT: Summerset Farms Phase 2 – 3875 W 2375 S, #55-20-009-018

This memo has been revised from a previous memo. Additional comments are given in italics. Our office has completed a review of the preliminary plans for the above-mentioned subdivision. The development is at 3875 west and 2375 South in Weber County. Phase 2 of the project entails the development of 17 lots ranging in size from 0.6 acres to 1.4 acres.

It is our request that the following changes items be completed:

- 1. 9 shares for this phase must be turned over to Hooper Irrigation Co. The review fees and connection fees must also be calculated and paid. *Still needed*.
- 2. Meters will be required on each of the lots in accordance with the Hooper irrigation standards. *Meters must be shown on the plans on in accordance with our details.*
- 3. Done On sheet 1, please add the secondary waterline to the standard roadway section.
- 4. *Done* On sheet 3, please add the word "combination" to the air vac planned for the high point in the pipeline near lot 33 to ensure a combination air vac is installed.
- 5. Construction standards for Hooper Irrigation must be met including locator tape, purple pipe, drains, valves and Combination Air-Vacs. Plans must be submitted showing these items. Please either show a general note indicating these requirements or a note on each sheet. Sheet one should mention this as it does other utilities.
- 6. *Done* An assigned board member must visit the site to review ditches. Please show all ditches on the full set of plans. *These are Wilson ditches*
- 7. *Done* The developer must meet with the Hooper Irrigation Board (2nd Monday each month). *Ed Green met with for phase 1*.

Construction plans will need to be submitted. Once plans are completed, all fees must be paid and shares received prior to approval of the development and issuance of the Will-Serve Letter. Please let us know if you have any questions.
