In consideration of the request for final approval of Eagle Ridge Cluster Subdivision Phase 6, located within the natural hazard study area of Weber County, the Weber County Engineering Division and Planning Division find that clear evidence exists that no study and report is necessary. Pursuant to LUC §108-22-5, the study and report requirement is hereby waived.

This waiver comes with the following findings and conditions:

### Findings:

- It has been determined by the Utah Geological Survey that the geologic unit within the subdivision is not associated with problem soil or landslide hazards, more specifically descried in Exhibit C.
- 2. Weber County is unaware of any existing risk due to unknown natural hazards on the site or in the area.
- 3. In the event there is a risk, it does not appear that the residential development of Eagle Ridge Cluster Subdivision Phase 6 will create a discernible increase in a manner known to Weber County at this time.

### Conditions:

- 1. This waiver shall not be construed as a waiver for future development on the site or in the area. It is based on the facts known to the Weber County Planning and Engineering Divisions at this time.
- 2. Weber County encourages the applicant to consult with a geologist or other qualified natural hazards expert to review and consider the effects of potential natural hazards, if any, on site or in the area.
- 3. In the event it is discovered that there is risk due to natural hazards on the site or in the area, the applicant shall report the findings to the County as soon as possible, and, if necessary, provide revised plans that mitigate the risk of the natural hazard.
