Subject: **Conditions of approval for the Junction City Chopper Show held September 18th, 2021**

In addition to meeting and maintaining compliance with the standards and requirements of the Weber County Code, the Junction City Chopper Show is approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1) No event parking is allowed on 1550 East Street south of the Tuscan Ridge Commercial Development parking lot entrance.
- 2) A "Type 3" traffic sign must be placed in 1550 East Street, at a point that is no further south than the Tuscan Ridge Commercial Development parking lot. The traffic sign shall read "ROAD CLOSED LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY." Near this location, two (2) A-Frame signs must also be placed (in an effective manner) near the edge of both travel lanes. These signs shall read "NO EVENT PARKING."
- 3) Band performances and any other event activities that cause noise levels above that of normal conversation shall end at or before 9:00pm. All event activities shall end at or before 10:00pm.
- 4) The stage location shall be changed so that all speakers are oriented to face north towards the commercial area of the existing neighborhood.
- 5) The event organizer shall provide notice, of the event taking place, to all residents that share a common property boundary. The notice shall include the name of the event and the date and time that the event will be held.
- 6) Event staff shall admit Weber County Sheriff Deputies and other county review agency representatives for periodic visits. Deputies will be informed of the conditions of approval and can assist with enforcement.
