

- General Comments:**
- 1. Cooking:** If there is to be any cooking equipment on site, what will it be?
  - 2. Storage and use of LPG (propane)** shall follow the applicable codes regarding its use and storage.
  - 3. Cooking may not be done under a tent structure which does not have a certificate of fire resistance.**

**Fire Pit:**

- The fire pit must meet the requirements for recreational fires outlined in the International Fire Code section 307.
  - Bon fires are fires larger than 3 feet in diameter and 2 feet in height. Bon fires require a permit from the Weber Fire District prior to use. Bonfires may not be located within 50 feet of any combustibles including structures.
  - A general recreational fire is a fire which is less than 3 feet in width and 2 feet in height. These do not require a permit **HOWEVER**, they must be constantly attended, have a means of extinguishment, and may not be located within 25 feet of any combustibles including structures.
