Attached is the letter of feasibility from our office for the purposed River Ranch 1st Amendment. For your information we do have the originally septic system permit and as-built. More importantly we have the paperwork associated with the existing well. Please be aware the Weber County has a new Land Use Ordinance that requires a 48 hour pump test on wells for properties being subdivided. The ordinance was not in place during the original approval in 2001, so it's likely that the Planning Department may direct you to complete that before the Mylar for the new subdivision could be singed. Lastly it appears that based on the location of the existing well you may intend to use the existing well as a shared well. It this is the case a shared well argument between you and the future property owner would need to be created, notarized, and recorded with the Weber County Recorder's office, a copy of the document would then need to be provided to our office. Once completed we would revise a well approval letter for you.
