REVIEW STATUS: APPROVED

SPECIFIC COMMENTS:

- 1. Prior to any combustible construction, the access road must meet requirements for fire vehicle access and the fire hydrant(s) must be installed and functional.
- 2. The building plans indicate that the home will have a 13R type fire suppression system. This type of system may be installed however it has different requirements than a 13D system which is intended for one and two family dwellings. A deferred submittal from the fire suppression contractor is required. Please clarify which system type is to be used.
- 3. Provide a temporary address marker at the building site during construction.
- 4. Roads shall have a maximum grade of 10% unless specifically approved as outlined by the International Fire Code.
- 5. Radius on all corners shall be a minimum of 28'-0".
- 6. Roads and bridges shall be designed, constructed and maintained to support an imposed load of 75,000 lbs.
- 7. All roads shall be designed, constructed, surfaced and maintained so as to provide an all-weather driving surface.
- 8. Fire access roads for this project shall be completed and approved prior to any combustible construction. Temporary roads shall meet the same requirements for height, width and imposed loads as permanent roads.
- 9. All required fire hydrants and water systems shall be installed, approved and fully functional prior to any combustible construction.
