In response to your questions that you posted on Miradi with regards to this project.

1. Culvert Issue. The GOAL Foundation-Ogden Marathon filed for and was approved for a Storm Water Construction Activity Permit. Project was completed and signed off by Blain Frandsen from Weber County Engineering Department. A V- ditch was constructed to handle all run off from culvert.
2. Overlay map from Utah Fish and Wildlife map shows the freshwater emergent on our plan filed with Weber County Planning. You will be able to see that no structures are planned within that zone now and in the future. We will continue to keep that area undisturbed to use as an education tool for our students as well as a buffer from traffic on road to the East of our property. Attached you will find a copy of the overlay.

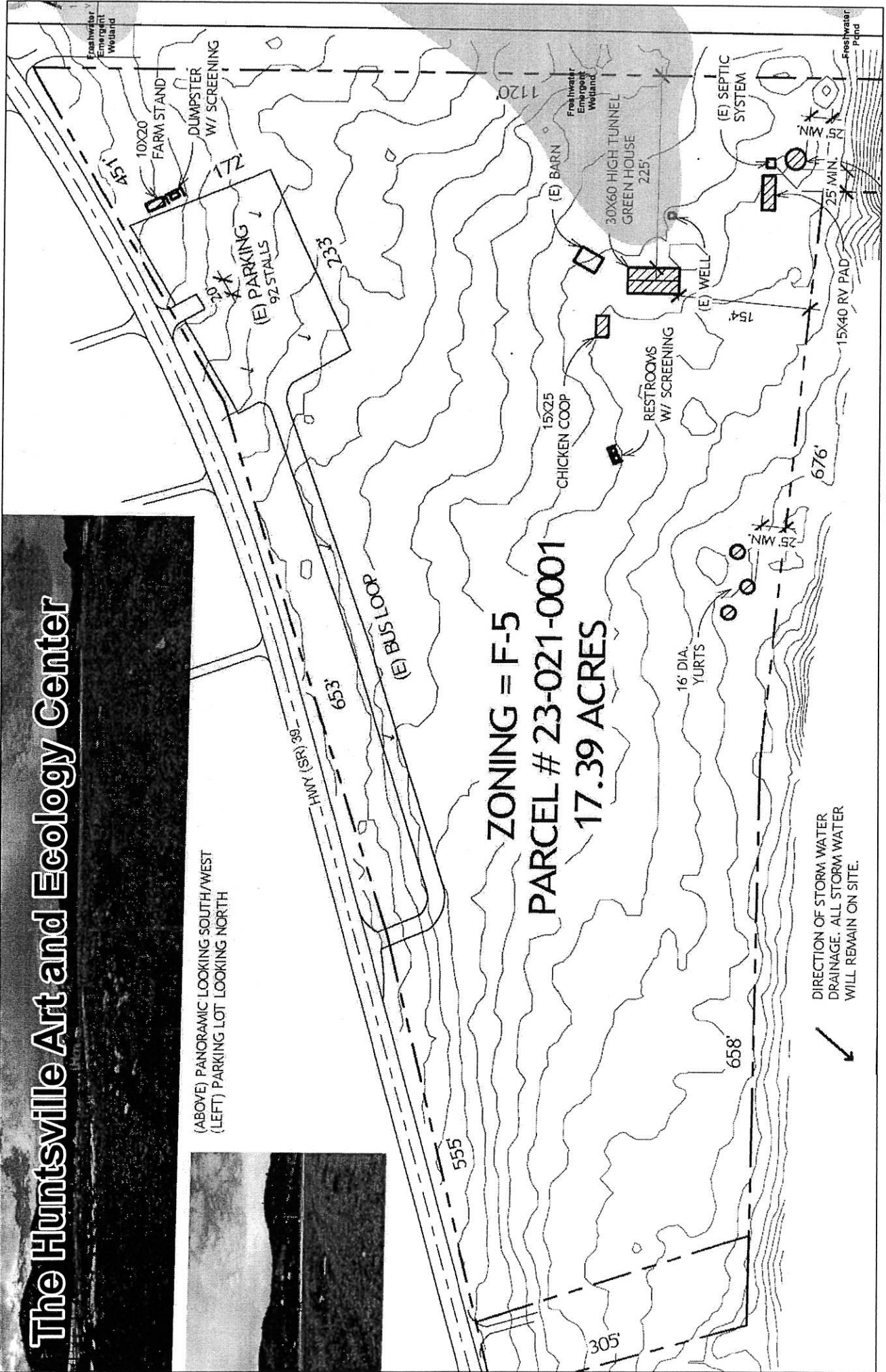
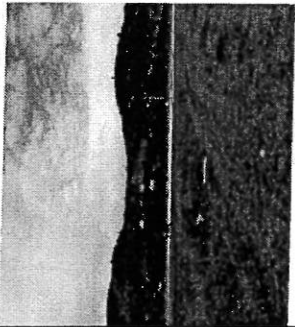
