Thank you for your review comments regarding this project. Below are our responses to these items:

- 1. An excavation permit will be submitted once the District selects a contractor for the work. The project is scheduled to bid out at the end of April and construction would begin in May or June.
- 2. A SWCAP application will be submitted after a contractor is selected but before any construction begins.
- 3. We can plan on having the contractor submit a SWPPP to the county as part of the SWCAP application but we feel that a UPDES permit with the State is not required. The site is less than one acre in size and is not part of a "common plan of development or sale". According to the rules associated with this permit, this site would not be required to obtain a permit. Let me know what you think.

As stated above, these items will be taken care of in May after a contractor is selected but the Conditional Use Permit is scheduled for review at the April Planning Commission meeting, is this going to be a problem?

I have had a chance to review the plan(s) and have the following comment(s): Written responses to the following comments are required.

- 1. An excavation permit is required for all work done within the County rights-of-way. Please contact the Engineering department for an excavation permit application.
- A Storm Water Construction Activity Permit (County issued) is required. Please contact the Engineering department for a SWCAP
 application.
- 3. A Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) is required to be submitted for all new development where construction is required. The State now requires that a Utah Discharge Pollution Elimination

Systems (UPDES) permit be acquired for all new development. A copy of the permit needs to be submitted to the County before final approval. Permits can now be obtained online thru the Utah Department of Environmental Quality at the following web site: https://secure.utah.gov/swp/client.

However, this review does not forego other items of concern that may come to this department's attention during additional reviews or during construction of improvements.
