- 3. If the ground is frozen, the water will not percolate into the ground.
- 4. The plans have been updated to indicated the historical flow paths. If the ponds are to overflow, the stormwater would follow the historical flow path.
- 5. All signs shown on plans are existing signs to remain. Plans have been updated to indicate that signs are existing.
