Submittal Checklist

The application shall include a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan which meets the criteria set forth in Section 33-3-4 of the county ordinances.

The applicant shall file the application on or before the following dates:

Subdivision: The date that the applicant submits the preliminary subdivision development plat application.
Site Plan: The date that the applicant submits a site plan application or amended site plan.
Building Permit: The date that the applicant submits a building permit application if the applicant proposes to construct a building on an existing lot or parcel.
Land Use Permit: The date that the applicant submits a land use permit application.
Other: At least two (2) weeks before the developer intends to perform any type of work not listed above that would require a Storm Water Construction Activity Permit pursuant to this Chapter.

Failure to acquire a required Storm Water Construction Activity Permit is grounds for tabling a related subdivision application, site plan application, conditional use permit application, or building permit application. It is unlawful to commence work (move dirt) on a development site before obtaining a required Storm Water Construction Activity Permit.

Note: A pre-costruction meeting is required before performing any on-site earth work, unless waived by the county engineer.

STORM WATER POLLUTION PROTECTION PLAN: (SWPPP)

1. LESS THAN 2,500 SQ/FT. FOR FOOTERS AND FLOOR.
2. THE OWNER WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CONDITIONS AT THE SITE.
3. CONSTRUCTION WILL BE DURING DAY LIGHT HOURS TO AVOID DISTURBING THE NEIGHBORS. OWNER WILL CONTACT NEIGHBORS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION AND PROVIDE A CONTACT PHONE NUMBER IN CASE OF EMERGENCY.
4. EXCAVATED MATERIAL WILL BE TEMPORARILY STORED NEXT TO THE SITE. AFTER CONSTRUCTION IS COMPLETE, OWNER WILL DISTRIBUTE EXCESS MATERIAL AROUND THE SITE.
5. CONCRETE WASH OUT WILL BE LOCATED AS NOTED ON PRINT. AFTER CONSTRUCTION IS COMPLETE, OWNER WILL REMOVE AND DISPOSE OF ALL CONCRETE DEBRIS
6. IF NEEDED, A PORTA-JOHN CAN BE DELIVERED FIVE DAY BEFORE FOR FOOTERS AND FLOOR CONSTRUCTION BEGINS AND REMOVED AS SOON AS CONCRETE CONTRACTORS ARE FINISHED. ERECTION OF THE QUONSET HUT WILL BE DONE BY OWNER AND BATHROOMS IN EXISTING HOME WILL BE USED.
7. CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCE ALREADY EXISTS BETWEEN EXISTING HOUSE AND NEW QUONSET HUT.
8. OWNER WILL REMOVE EXCESSIVE MUD FROM ROAD AS NEEDED.
9. THERE ARE A FEW IRRIGATION DITCHES AROUND THE CIRCUMFERENCE OF THE PROPERTY. NO ACTIVE DITCHES WITHIN 60 FT. OF THE CONSTRUCTION SITE..
10. CURRENTLY RAIN AND STORM WATER IS ABSORBED INTO THE GROUND OF THE FIELD THAT CURRENTLY EXISTS AT THE CONSTRUCTION SITE.
11. THE EXISTING STRUCTURE HAVE BEEN LABELED. THE SITE IS AN AGRICULTURAL FIELD. CURRENTLY IN ALFALFA AND GRASS HAY.
