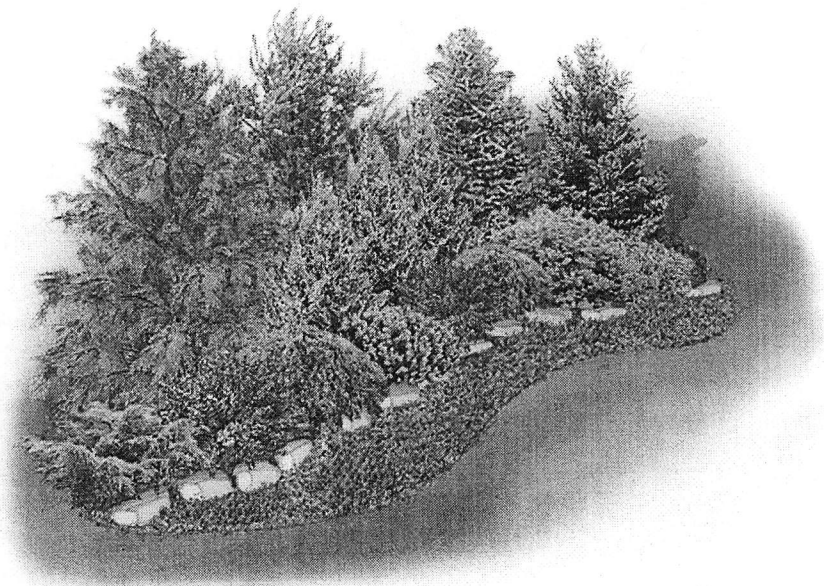

Evergreen Screen Landscape Plan

Gain privacy without sacrificing beauty. This evergreen screen will provide year-round seclusion, a home for wildlife, and a feast for the eyes.



It's prettier than a hedge and friendlier than a stockade fence. And it even invites birds to your garden. What is it? An evergreen screen, featuring a mosaic of hardy and easy-care plants that won't break the bank (or your back when it comes to maintenance). Tall hemlock, pine, and spruce trees create the backdrop for a mix of mainly evergreen plants with color and texture. Two deciduous plants--burgundy Japanese barberry and variegated ajuga--add pleasing color contrast to this low-maintenance landscape.

- A) Gold Coast juniper (*Juniperus x pfitzeriana* 'Gold Coast'), Zones 4-9
- B) Canada hemlock (*Tsuga canadensis*), Zones 4-8
- C) Japanese barberry (*Berberis thunbergii* 'Atropurpurea'), Zones 5-8
- D) Bugleweed (*Ajuga reptans* 'Variegata'), Zones 3-9
- E) Threadleaf false cypress (*Chamaecyparis pisifera* 'Golden Mop'), Zones 4-8
- F) Bird's-nest spruce (*Picea abies* 'Nidiformis'), Zones 3-7
- G) Wichita Blue juniper (*Juniperus scopulorum* 'Wichita Blue'), Zones 3-7
- H) Eastern white pine (*Pinus strobus*), Zones 4-9
- I) Colorado blue spruce (*Picea pungens* f. *glauca*), Zones 2-8
- J) Black Hills spruce (*Picea glauca* var. *densata*), Zones 2-6
