The referenced Notice of Intent to Commence Small Mining Operations (NOI), received by the Division March 7, 2011, is complete **with the exception of the reclamation bonding requirement.** The reclamation surety is determined to be \$25,100, for the proposed 5-acre site. This was determined based on:

Please submit the reclamation surety and reclamation contract within the next 30 days. No mining related disturbance can be created until the surety is received and approved, and you have received written acceptance from this office as well as other applicable agencies.

The reclamation surety can be submitted in one of several forms, including, an irrevocable letter of credit, a certificate of deposit, cash or a surety bond. Please contact Penny Berry at (801) 538-5291 or e-mail bondcoordinator@utah.gov for assistance in completing this requirement.

The Division has forwarded the Cultural Resource Survey to the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) with a determination of no adverse impacts on significant cultural resources. The Division allows SHPO 10 days to concur with this determination before we can issue final approval. This will allow you some time to obtain the surety.
