Yes — this calculation includes the shrubs, perennials and grasses plus all the preparation, mulch and irrigation required within the shrub beds.

For this phase it would include 135 - 5 gallon shrubs, 224 - 1 gallon perennials and 118 - 1 gallon grasses. All within the 13,918 SF of beds we have.

You could argue that you could go down to 2.25 or 2.50 a SF since we have a majority of the plants at 1 gallon in these beds.

Does that make sense?
