Submittal Checklist

The application shall include a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan which meets the criteria set forth in Section 33-3-4 of the county ordinances.

The applicant shall file the application on or before the following dates:

Subdivision: The date that the applicant submits the preliminary subdivision development plat application.

Site Plan: The date that the applicant submits a site plan application or amended site plan.

Building Permit: The date that the applicant submits a building permit application if the applicant proposes to construct a building on an existing lot or parcel.

Land Use Permit: The date that the applicant submits a land use permit application.

Other: At least two (2) weeks before the developer intends to perform any type of work not listed above that would require a Storm Water Construction Activity Permit pursuant to this Chapter.

Failure to acquire a required Storm Water Construction Activity Permit is grounds for tabling a related subdivision application, site plan application, conditional use permit application, or building permit application. It is unlawful to commence work (move dirt) on a development site before obtaining a required Storm Water Construction Activity Permit.

Note: A pre-construction meeting is required before performing any on-site earth work, unless waived by the county engineer.



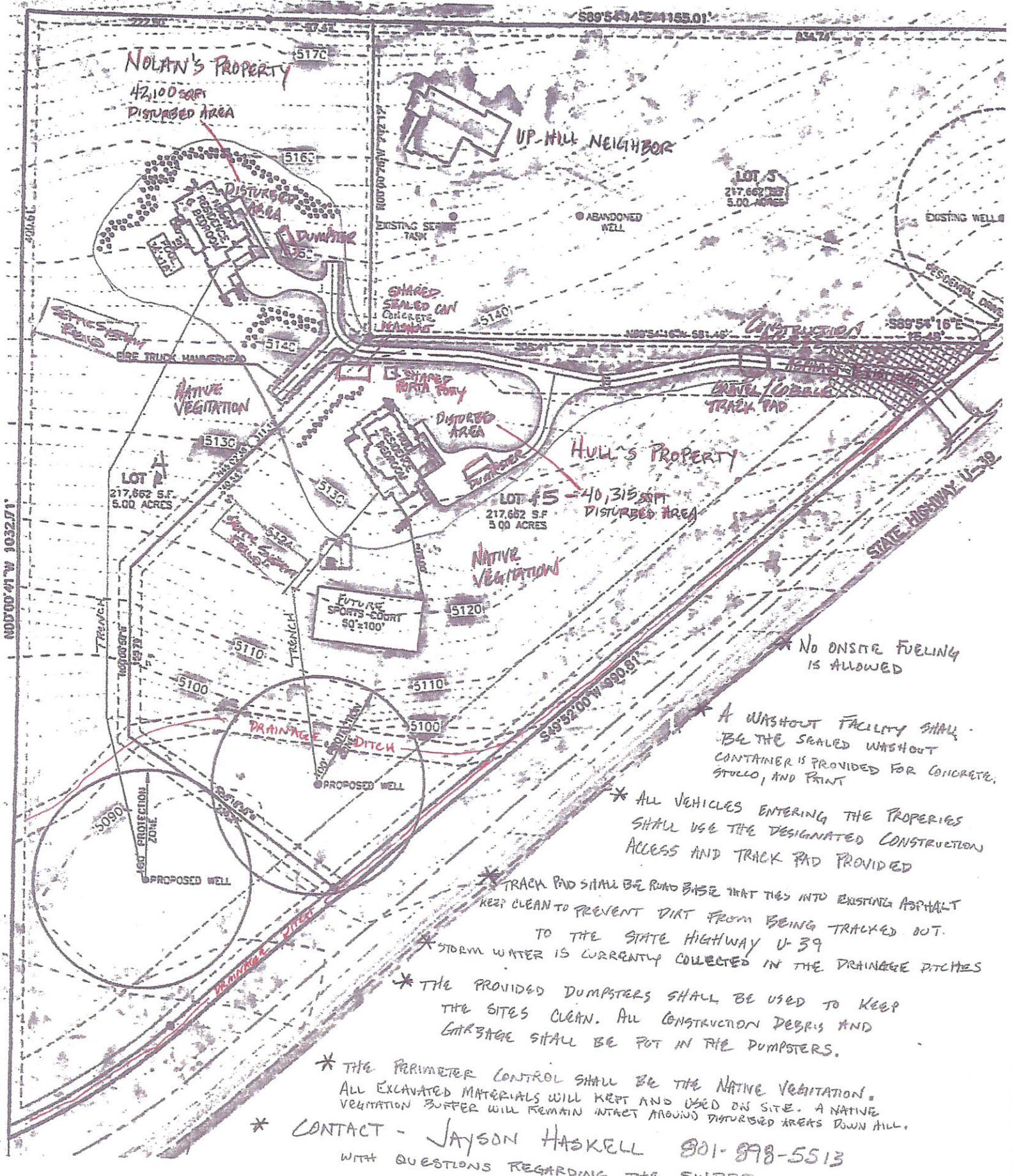

A WASHOUT FACILITY SHALL BE THE SEALED WASHOUT CONTAINER IS PROVIDED FOR CONCRETE, STUCCO, AND PAINT

* ALL VEHICLES ENTERING THE PROPERTIES SHALL USE THE DESIGNATED CONSTRUCTION ACCESS AND TRACK PAD PROVIDED

* TRACK PAD SHALL BE ROAD BASE THAT TIES INTO EXISTING ASPHALT KEEP CLEAN TO PREVENT DIRT FROM BEING TRACKED OUT TO THE STATE HIGHWAY U-39

* STORM WATER IS CURRENTLY COLLECTED IN THE DRAINAGE DITCHES

* THE PROVIDED DUMPSTERS SHALL BE USED TO KEEP THE SITES CLEAN. ALL CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS AND GARBAGE SHALL BE PUT IN THE DUMPSTERS.

* THE PERIMETER CONTROL SHALL BE THE NATIVE VEGETATION. ALL EXCAVATED MATERIALS WILL BE KEPT AND USED ON SITE. A NATIVE VEGETATION BUFFER WILL REMAIN INTACT AROUND DISTURBED AREAS DOWN HILL.
