Summary and Background

The applicant is requesting an administrative design review approval to replace the Middle Bowl Chairlift, located on the Forest Service property, parcel 23-004-0001. LUC Sec. 108-1 (Design Review) requires that all commercial projects comply with the Design Review requirements. Because the proposed lifts have a footprint less than 75,000 square feet, the proposal can be approved by the Planning Director.

Snowbasin made application in 2010, and received an approval to become the Ogden Valley Destination and Recreation Resort Zone on January 11, 2011. The resort, as a result of the rezone, is subject to Weber County Zoning Development Agreement #C2011-05 (E#2511941), dated January 19, 2011.

Analysis

As part of a design review, the Planning Director shall consider applicable codes and impose conditions that mitigate deficiencies if necessary. Consideration is given to the following:

- Traffic safety and traffic congestion:
 - No new streets are proposed. Traffic hazards and congestion are not anticipated with this proposal.
- Outdoor advertising:
 - o The project will not include any outdoor advertising.
- Landscaping:

- The project is on the forest property and there is no proposed landscaping other than the naturally forested area around the lift and terminals.
- According to the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (page 4 of the SWPPP), the developer will re-seed disturbed areas with native soil mix to achieve final stabilization.
- Building and site layout:
 - The only structures that are associated with this project are the lift terminals at the end points of the lift line. Each terminal structure will have a footprint of approximately 2,000 square feet and will have a similar appearance to the existing terminals.

- Utility easements, drainage, and other engineering questions:
 - The proposal must meet all review agency requirements, including the requirements outlined in the Engineering Division's review. To-date, the applicant has complied with all engineering review comments.
 - The applicant has submitted a geotechnical and geologic hazards report prepared by GSH Geotechnical, Inc. The report is dated, July 26, 2021 and listed as project no. 3361-002-21.
 Regarding geologic hazards, the report states the following:

Based upon the findings of this review, we believe that the proposed re- alignment is not adversely exposed to the geological hazards specified in the Section 108-22 Natural Hazard Areas of the Weber County Code (2021). (Pg. 12, Snowbasin Geological and Geotechnical Reconnaissance, 2021).

- Prior development concept plan approvals associated with any rezoning agreement, planned commercial or manufacturing rezoning, or planned residential unit development approval:
 - The proposed project complies with the previously approved Snowbasin Master Plan and the applicable zoning development agreement.

Conformance to the General Plan

The proposal conforms to the Ogden Valley General Plan by continuing development and improvements to Snowbasin Resort (pg. 44 Ogden Valley General Plan Parks and Recreation Implementation 1.2.2).

Staff Recommendation

The Planning Division recommends approval of DR 2021-10, subject to all review agency requirements and based on the following condition of approval:

1. During construction of this project, the developer must follow any recommendations of the geologic hazards report and geotechnical report prepared by GSH.

This recommendation for design review approval is based on the following findings:

- 1. The proposed project complies with applicable County codes.
- 2. The proposed project complies with the applicable Zoning Development Agreement and approved Snowbasin Master Plan.
- 3. The proposed project conforms to the Ogden Valley General Plan.
- 4. The proposed project will not negatively affect public health, safety, or welfare.
- 5. The proposed project will not deteriorate the environment of the general area so as to negatively impact surrounding properties and uses.

Administrative Approval

Administrative approval granted on August 3, 2021 based on the analysis, findings, and conditions listed in this staff report.
