Submittal Checklist

The application shall include a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan which meets the criteria set forth in Section 33-3-4 of the county ordinances.

The applicant shall file the application on or before the following dates:

Subdivision: The date that the applicant submits the preliminary subdivision development plat application.

Site Plan: The date that the applicant submits a site plan application or amended site plan.

Building Permit: The date that the applicant submits a building permit application if the applicant proposes to construct a building on an existing lot or parcel.

Land Use Permit: The date that the applicant submits a land use permit application.

Other: At least two (2) weeks before the developer intends to perform any type of work not listed above that would require a Storm Water Construction Activity Permit pursuant to this Chapter.

Failure to acquire a required Storm Water Construction Activity Permit is grounds for tabling a related subdivision application, site plan application, conditional use permit application, or building permit application. It is unlawful to commence work (move dirt) on a development site before obtaining a required Storm Water Construction Activity Permit.

Note: A pre-construction meeting is required before performing any on-site earth work, unless waived by the county engineer.



Applicant Narrative

PacifiCorp has retained Plant Reclamation, a specialized demolition contractor, to completely demolish their Little Mountain Power Plant Facility. The plant consists mainly of a gas turbine with heat recovery boiler and a separate auxiliary boiler together with associated support and auxiliary systems for water treatment, compressed air and bearing cooling water. Demolition also includes the control building and the separate maintenance shop. The project includes the removal of the foundations and building slabs.
