DRINKING WATER WILL SERVE LETTER

The letter is to notify Weber County that Terakee Farms, Inc., a Utah Corporation, has been organized under the laws of the State of Utah to manage Terakee PRUD open space, agricultural parcels, private right of ways, secondary water shares and related systems, AND DRINKING WATER. Pursuant to Terakee Farms Corporate Bylaws, TERAKEE WATER COMPANY, a DBA organized under the laws of the State of Utah, WILL SERVE drinking water for Terakee Farms PRUD Subdivision.

TERAKEE WATER COMPANY will provide DRINKING WATER services to residential lots for the full Terakee Farms PRUD Subdivision consisting of 206 residential units. Furthermore, *A capacity assessment under the guidance of the Utah Division of Drinking Water, Utah Division of Water Rights, and Great Basin Engineering has been prepared and provided to Weber County:*

- **FULL PROJECT:** 206 Residential Units requires 92.7 acre feet of water (206 multiplied by 0.45 acre feet); and,
- **PHASE NO. 1 ONLY:** 40 Residential Units requires 18.0 acre feet of water (40 multiplied by 0.45 acres feet).

Terakee Farms, Inc. owns 508.04 acre feet of water as evidenced through water rights owned with the State of Utah. Together with the secondary water requirements as detailed in the Secondary Water Study provided by Great Basin

Engineering, the FULL PROJECT requires 248.26 acre feet of water for secondary purposes. Together with the drinking water requirements; Terkee Farms PRUD requires 340.96 acre feet of water. Terakee Farms, Inc. excess capacity is 167.08 acre feet of water.
