- 1. Noted
- 2. Connection to the 24" ductile iron pipe on 2550.
- 3. HIC sumps have been specified at the end of the irrigation lines.
- 4. An automatic air valve has been specified on plans.
- 5. The irrigation laterals for Lots 5, 14, and 15 have been shown 6' from the water meter.
- 6. Noted.
- 7. The fence has been specified to be a solid wall vinyl fence.
- 8. A sewer note is on the plans that call for 18" steel casing extending 4' beyond high bank boths sides of canal.
- 9. The "no drainage" note was added to Sheet 2
- 10. General note 5 was updated to include Hooper Irrigation Company Standard.
- 11. The details have been removed.
- 12. The profiles have been updated.
- 13. The canal has been shown and noted on Sheet 12. The approval letter will be provided to the County.
- 14. A note on the SWPPP has been provided to include silt fencing for the length of the sewer extension.
