Subdivisions that have received preliminary plan approval shall have 18 months from the date of the preliminary approval to receive final approval of the subdivision or the first phase if applicable. An extension of preliminary approval for an additional time of up to 18 months may be granted by the planning director upon repayment of the subdivision application fees and the plan being brought into compliance with county, state, and federal laws current at the time the extension is approved. The extension request shall be submitted and approved prior to the expiration of the original approval period. Only two time extensions for preliminary plan/plat extensions will be granted.
