

-Medical Staging Areas: These areas will be marked, strategically placed throughout the attraction to ensure quick response times. These staging areas will have medical supplies and equipment.

Medical Evacuation Strategies and Staging Locations:

-Designated Evacuation Points: Evacuation points will be clearly marked, situated at easily accessible areas within the attraction.

-Emergency Assembly Area: An assembly point outside the attraction will be designated for medical emergencies requiring immediate evacuation.

-Ambulance Access Points: Points of entry for ambulances to access the site will be identified and communicated to all medical personnel.

Incident Reporting:

All staff members will be trained to report incidents to the nearest medical personnel, who will then relay information to the Medical Coordinator. Detailed incident reports will be filled out for each case.

Staff Training:
