This Acknowledgement Letter is to serve as a Memorandum of Understanding for both

West Warren Water Company, hereinafter named, "Utility" and the joint developers Fenex

Development & Flagship Homes, hereinafter named, "Developers".

Developers own property within the water service district operated by the Utility.

Developers intend to develop said property and have approached the Utility with the desire

to study and create a Master Water Infrastructure Plan which will include significant

Agreement the Utility will then provide a Will Serve Letter to Developers for delivery to the

County of Weber for ultimate approval of the project.
