

Eden Epic Operational Plan

The Eden Epic mountain bike event has one distance. It is 50 miles long, has four aid stations and it is generally held in September. For 2024 it will be held on July 27th..

It starts at Liberty Park and heads on road to where the pavement turns to dirt on the Avon Pass Road. From there Riders continue up the Avon Pass Road to the ATV trail where they will use that to connect to the Willard Basin Road. The Riders will continue up the Willard Basin Road to the skyline Trail. from there they will follow the skyline trail to the North Ogden Divide, then up toward Lewis Peak and down to Windsurfer Beach. From Windsurfer Beach they will continue on the North arm Trail and then following the Eden bike path back to the finish line at Liberty park.

The ride starts at 7:00 a.m.

The event has three Aid Station locations:

- 1. Willard Basin Road
- 2. Willard Basin Campground
- 3. Parking Lot at the top of the divide
- 4. Windsurfer Beach trailhead

Each Aid Station is supplied with basic first aid supplies as well as the food and liquid for hydration.

The Finish Line is supplied with Medical staff and first aid supplies.

The Sheriff's department and the local fire station are made aware of a potential call out in the case of serious injury or sickness.

Restrooms will be provided at the start line and the finish line. Riders will also use the FS toilets at the top of the North Ogden Divide and Windsurfers beach.

Posters will be posted at the trailheads 1-2 weeks in advance of the event to make trail users aware of the use of the trail on event day and encourage them to coexist and get along.
